Purpose: To establish a policy that prohibits the use of tobacco products on school grounds or at school activities by visitors.

The use of any tobacco products by visitors is prohibited on school property.

For purposes of this policy:

1. "School property" shall mean all properties owned, leased, rented, or otherwise used by a school, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. All interior portions of any building or other structure used for instruction, administration, support services, maintenance, or storage.
 - b. Any indoor facility or portion of such facility owned or leased or contracted for and used for the provision of regular or routine health care, day care, or early childhood development (Head Start) services.
 - c. All vehicles used by the division for transporting students, staff, visitors, or other persons.
 - d. All outdoor facilities including those used for instruction, extra-curricular activities, and parking.

- e. All property surrounding buildings and structures, parking lots, or any other outdoor property owned, leased, or rented by the school.
2. "Tobacco" includes cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, bidi, snuff, chewing tobacco and all other kinds and forms of tobacco prepared in such a manner as to be suitable for chewing, dipping, and/or smoking. "Tobacco" also includes cloves or any other product packaged for smoking.
3. "Tobacco use" means the lighting, chewing, dipping, inhaling, or smoking of any tobacco product while on school property, grounds, or at school-sponsored events or activities on or off campus at any time, including non-school hours.
4. "Smoking" means the carrying or holding of any lighted pipe, cigar, or cigarette of any kind, or any other lighted smoking equipment, or the lighting, inhaling, or exhaling of smoke from a pipe, cigar, or cigarette of any kind.

Each principal shall post signs stating "No Smoking," or containing the international "No Smoking" symbol, consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a bar across it in conspicuous locations on the school campus.

This policy shall be announced at school activities as directed by the building principal.

Visitors found to be in violation of this policy shall be asked to comply immediately. Those failing to comply with the policy will be required to leave school grounds.
